PASA is seeking a full-time Special Projects Coordinator to help coordinate PASA's high school programs. The Special Projects Coordinator will be involved in the development, operations, and expansion of PASA's systems building work.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

Program Coordination & Relationship Building

- Coordinate the implementation of PASA's high school credit bearing advanced coursework, offered in partnership with the Rhode Island Department of Education (RIDE), community organizations and participating Providence high schools.
- Assist PASA's youth and program assessment work by managing stakeholder communications and logistics
- Develop and facilitate partner orientations, teacher trainings,
- Provide ongoing technical assistance and manage partner engagement in their work with PASA
- Serve as a liaison with RIDE, community partners, vendors, students, families and school/district staff
- Work closely with RIDE, Providence Public School District, community partners, and school administrators to recruit and retain youth participants

Data and Program Quality

- Utilize data to support partners, inform decisions, and ensure long-term youth and program outcomes
- Oversee aspects of PASA's continuous quality improvement process including system, program, and youth level outcomes
- Assist PASA and its partners in refining a digital badge system linked to youth assessments

Skills Required:

- Ability to work with a wide-range of community and school partners in developing effective, collaborative partnerships and learning experiences
- Ability to synthesize large amounts of information and communicate it effectively to different audiences
- Ability to navigate in and out-of-school issues and interact with community partners and schoolbased practitioners
- Ability to think strategically about out-of-school time initiatives as related to the State's vision for education

- Confidence in managing multi-level partnerships and projects
- Bachelor's degree or equivalent community-based experience, along with 1 year of related professional work
