Job Description

PASA is seeking a full-time Expanded Learning Coordinator to help coordinate programs for high school students offered through the statewide All Course Network. The Expanded Learning Coordinator will be involved in the development, operations, and expansion of PASA's credit-bearing out-of-school time opportunities as well as overall participation in PASA's high school focused work.

Responsibilities

Coordinate PASA's credit-bearing after school programs for high school students, offered in partnership with community organizations through RI Department of Education's statewide All Course Network.

- Work with RIDE, community partners, and school staff to recruit, register, and retain youth participants as well as complete required paperwork and data submissions
- Develop and facilitate trainings as well as provide technical assistance for partners
- Utilize data to support partners, inform decisions, and ensure long-term youth and program outcomes
- Assist PASA and its partners in implementing a digital badge system linked to youth assessments

Attributes
