

Appendix A- AfterZone Summer Scholars 2016

Camp Daily Program Overview

Youth:

- Youth will participate in groups of approximately 28 students; anticipating 112-224 youth participants per school site. There will be 500 youth served from all seven middle schools.
- PASA will coordinate with the district, principals, and AfterZone staff regarding targeted recruitment of youth
- Youth and families will have the option of transportation to and from home neighborhoods via school buses
- Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided for all youth

Program:

- **4-Week Program- July 5th through July 29th, 2016**
- Four-day program, Monday through Thursday, with an End of Summer Celebration on Friday, July 29th
- Youth arrive at 9:00 a.m. and depart at 3 p.m. (6 hours per day)

STEM Education Teams (Morning Camp Experience):

Each youth will participate in a four day program, with **two days at a community-based STEM learning locations and two days at the school**. The experience will be planned and facilitated by the STEM Education Teams, which will consist of a **Community Educator** (from an AfterZone partner organization), a **School Day Educator**, and an **AfterZone Educator**. A sample daily schedule appears below:

8:30 am: Official start time for educator sign-in

8:30 am-9:00 am: STEM team daily planning in classroom

9:00 am-9:30 am: Youth arrive. Educators will monitor breakfast, ensure sign-in of youth, and supervise clean-up

9:30 am: Instructional time begins in classroom or transportation leaves for off-site location

11:00 am-11:30 am: BREAK; Educators will distribute snack, facilitate camp activity

11:30 am-1:00 pm: Instructional time

1:00 pm: Learning program ends for the day; educators will escort youth to lunch

1:00 pm-1:30 pm: STEM team plans for following day

1:30 pm – 2:30 pm: Afternoon enrichment programming for youth

2:30 pm – 3:00 pm: Dismissal

The two days spent at the school will include:

- **Guided Inquiry based curricula** developed by all educators within the STEM team, connecting the field experiences to relevant academic concepts
- **Targeted instruction in mathematics** connected thematically with the community-based STEM program. All math instruction and curriculum development will be led by the STEM education team and supported by an additional school site Instructional Specialist
- **Team building activities** that contribute to positive youth development and provide program identity
- **STEM challenges** that utilize problem solving and group processes skills

AfterZone (Afternoon Camp Experience):

After lunch youth will participate in both “Club AfterZone” and AfterZone enrichment programs each week, running during the hour afternoon block

- Youth will choose two 2-day enrichment programs (Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday) to participate in each week; these high quality programs in arts, sports, and skill-building will be led by grant-funded AfterZone program providers.
- In the opposite days to their enrolled program, youth will participate in AfterZone staff led activities during Club AfterZone.
