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# what is an afterzone ?

This year 1,900 Providence public middle school students will enjoy fun, safe after-school programs—ranging from sports, arts and music, to hands-on science--in the Providence After School Alliance's (PASA) AfterZone. We'd like your child to be one of them--**for free!** Because PASA works closely with the schools, your child can sign up for an AfterZone program of their choice in their school, four sessions per year (fall, winter, spring, and summer).

**WELCOME TO AFTERZONE SUMMER STEM CAMP!** The **AfterZone Summer STEM Camp** is an **integrated hands-on, project-based STEM** (science, technology, engineering and math) **program**, integrating math and English language arts. The AfterZone Summer STEM Camp is a Field-Based Program with elements of summer camp, the arts, and fun!

- **Students are required to attend ALL days** that the AfterZone Summer STEM Camp is session from: **July 3, 2017 – August 4, 2017, Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM with an End of Summer Celebration on Friday, August 4.**
- **Summer program is a FREE program and includes breakfast and lunch. Transportation is provided to your school and home for pickup and drop-off.**
- Youth will spend most of their day with a team of adult educators who will serve as guides during their summer experience. In addition youth will have the opportunity to sign up for a different afternoon program, such as arts, sports or skill based activities.
- Students who have more than two unexcused absences may be removed from programs.

Please note that **students are enrolled on a “first-come, first-served” basis**, so the sooner your child returns this brochure, the more likely they are to have a spot. We can't guarantee that students will be enrolled in programs they select, but we will offer other available programs similar to their choice program or put them on a waiting list for their chosen program. Parents will receive written confirmation and a phone call letting them know if their child has been accepted for programs.

### **Fashion Futures**

Provided by Providence CityArts for Youth

Emerging Designers in CityArts Fashion Futures will design and create their own fashion lines for Summer 2017! Designers will go from inspiration, to textile production, dyeing, fabric experimentation, to hand-sewing, to Ready-To-Wear outfits! Designers will show their debut collections at the Summer Scholars Runway Show at the end-of-session! This program is **available for students entering 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grades in the 2017-2018 school year.**

### **River Adventures**

As a River Adventurer you will explore the Woonasquatucket River, which is right in your back yard! This is an outdoor program, so you should join if you want to enjoy the summer sun! In the AfterZone Summer STEM Camp, our goal is to help your child reach his or her full potential, socially, emotionally, and academically. In order to do that, we share some information about your child with the Providence Public School Department and they share some information about your child with us. PPSD and PASA are partners in creating a full year learning experience for your child, and sharing this information can help us better serve your child and understand if the program is having a positive impact on your child's academic and social/emotional success. Additionally, PASA works with third party evaluation partners to improve the quality of program experiences for your child, and therefore must share information with them as well. PASA establishes strict confidentiality agreements with everyone with whom we share information.

## **What types of information do we share?**

The AfterZone Summer STEM Camp sometimes shares the information we collect from you and your child with your child's school and our evaluation partners and stores that information on a password protected data management system operated by a third party. Examples of the type of information we might share are his/her attendance in the AfterZone Summer STEM Camp and responses on surveys.

## **What is the AfterZone asking for and why?**

We would like your permission to share the information we collect from you and your child with your child's school as well as our evaluation partners. Examples of the type of information we would share are his or her attendance in PASA and responses on surveys. If the AfterZone Summer STEM Camp provides this kind of information to your child's school, then we will be better able to provide services for your child. Similarly, providing this information to our evaluation partners allows PASA better design programs for your children in the future.
