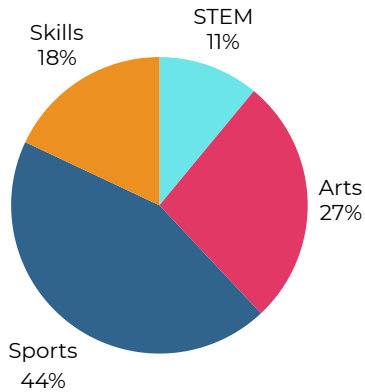

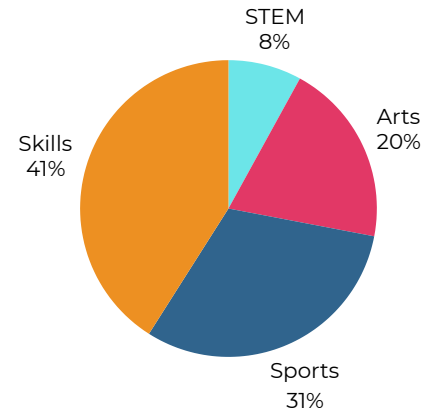

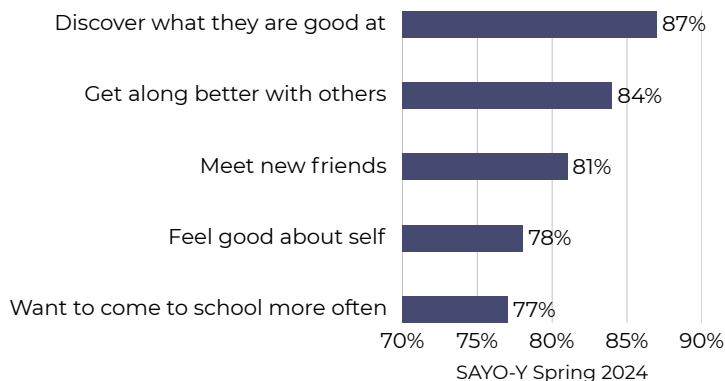
AfterZone Middle School Initiative



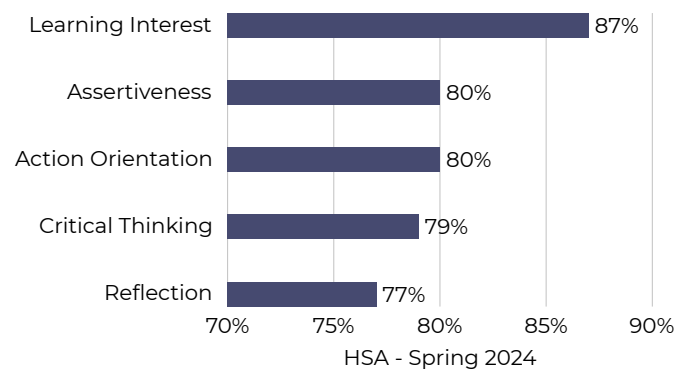
Hub High School Initiative



Percentage of youth reporting AfterZone programs helped them to

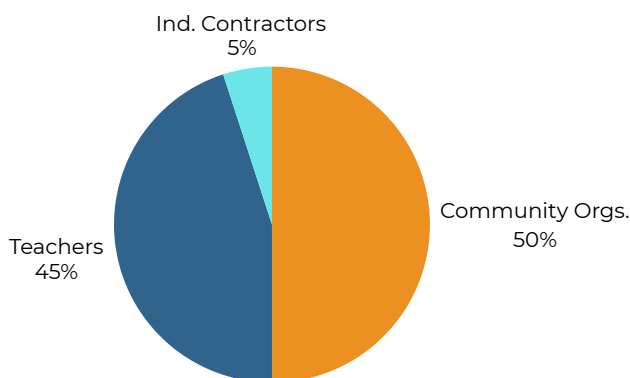


Average increased change reported by Hub youth since beginning the program
